

## COVID-19 safety

The teams at the Warwickshire Event Centre and BIGGA will continue to monitor and act on advice from the UK government, Public Health England and the World Health Organisation, regarding precautions on COVID-19 and adjust these standards accordingly.

In line with Government guidance, to help stop the spread of coronavirus, the venue remains temporarily closed and this is likely to be the case until January 2021 at the earliest.



Measures to protect the safety of attendees when the venue reopens will include:

- Being accredited by Visit England with [We're Good to Go](#)
- Having approved COVID-19 risk assessments in place
- Providing hand sanitiser stations around the site at key locations
- An increased cleaning regime in place in toilets
- High touch areas will be cleaned regularly
- Depending on the restrictions in place, BIGGA will work together with the venue to manage numbers and arrival patterns and ensure social distancing requirements are in place
- Depending on restrictions, attendees will be pre-registered attendees so we can measure attendance numbers and to help with track and trace if still required in June 2021.
- We may require visitors to wear face coverings depending on government guidelines at the time and to be aware of social distancing.
